Complaints

I wish to make a complaints against the following:

The Prime Minister in her personal capacity:

That she knowingly and recklessly called a purported general election in the islands of Orkney and Shetland with the intention of defrauding the people of those islands of their inheritance, their innate sovereignty, their land and their power. That she did this in the prior knowledge that no court, when challenged, has heard any proof that either Shetland or Orkney are part of Scotland and that there was no legal basis for such an election.

The Electoral Commission in its corporate capacity:

That it knowingly and recklessly organised a purported general election in the islands of Orkney and Shetland with the intention of defrauding the people of those islands of their inheritance, their innate sovereignty, their land and their power. That it did this in the prior knowledge that no court, when challenged, has heard any proof that either Shetland or Orkney are part of Scotland and that there was no legal basis for such an election.

Jan Robert Riise, Executive Manager at SIC in his personal capacity:

That he knowingly and recklessly took part in organising a purported general election in the islands of Orkney and Shetland with the intention of defrauding the people of those islands of their inheritance, their innate sovereignty, their land and their power. That he did this in the prior knowledge that no court, when challenged, has heard any proof that either Shetland or Orkney are part of Scotland and that there was no legal basis for such an election.

That he neglected his duty as Deputy Returning Officer to ensure that any election was carried out on a legal basis. That he failed to apply due diligence in the face of evidence presented to him.

Alistair Buchan, Chief Executive at OIC in his personal capacity:

That he knowingly and recklessly took part in organising a purported general election in the islands of Orkney and Shetland with the intention of defrauding the people of those islands of their inheritance, their innate sovereignty, their land and their power. That he did this in the prior knowledge that no court, when challenged, has heard any proof that either Shetland or Orkney are part of Scotland and that there was no legal basis for such an election.

That he neglected his duty as Returning Officer to ensure that any election was carried out on a legal basis. That he failed to apply due diligence in the face of evidence presented to him.

Alistair Carmichael of Orkney in his personal capacity:

That he knowingly and recklessly took part in a purported general election in the islands of Orkney and Shetland and, having received the most votes, pledged allegiance to a foreign occupying power with the intention of defrauding the people of those islands of their inheritance, their innate sovereignty, their land and their power. That he did this in the prior knowledge that no court, when challenged, has heard any proof that either Shetland or Orkney are part of Scotland. He is accused of misrepresentation and purporting to represent the people of Orkney and Shetland on a fraudulent basis

Documents supporting these allegations are enclosed herewith. You will note that all those involved were advised of their position well before the purported election took place and that therefore all acted in full knowledge. Please reply quoting the reference number under which these complaints are being investigated.

Should you wish to speak to me on this or any other matter, please do not send your officers to my address. My partner finds it upsetting in the extreme. I will attend the police station at you invitation by phone or email should that be required.
